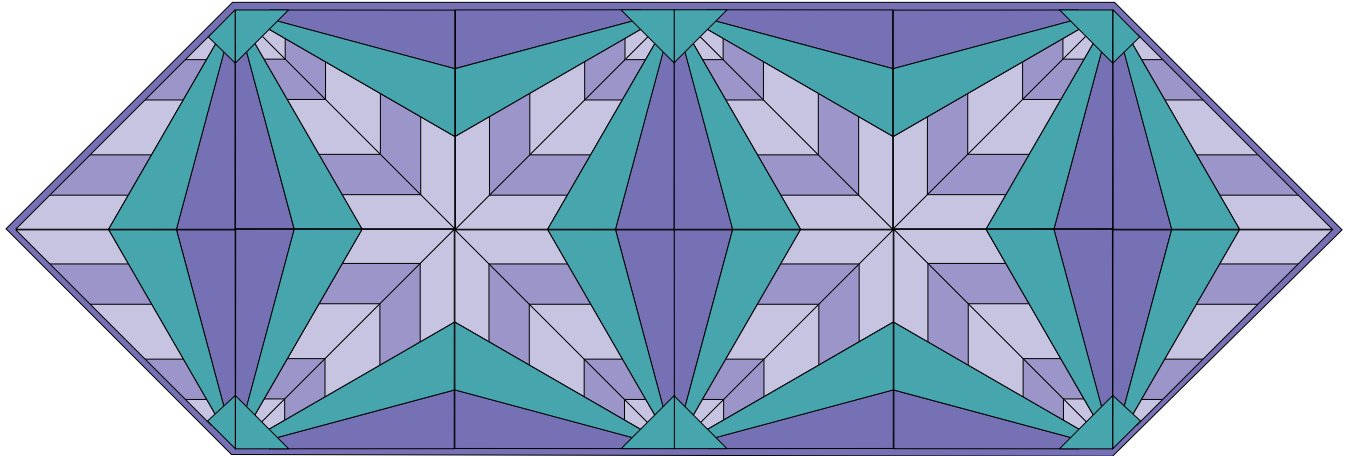


# Striped Stars



Finished runner: 48" x 16"

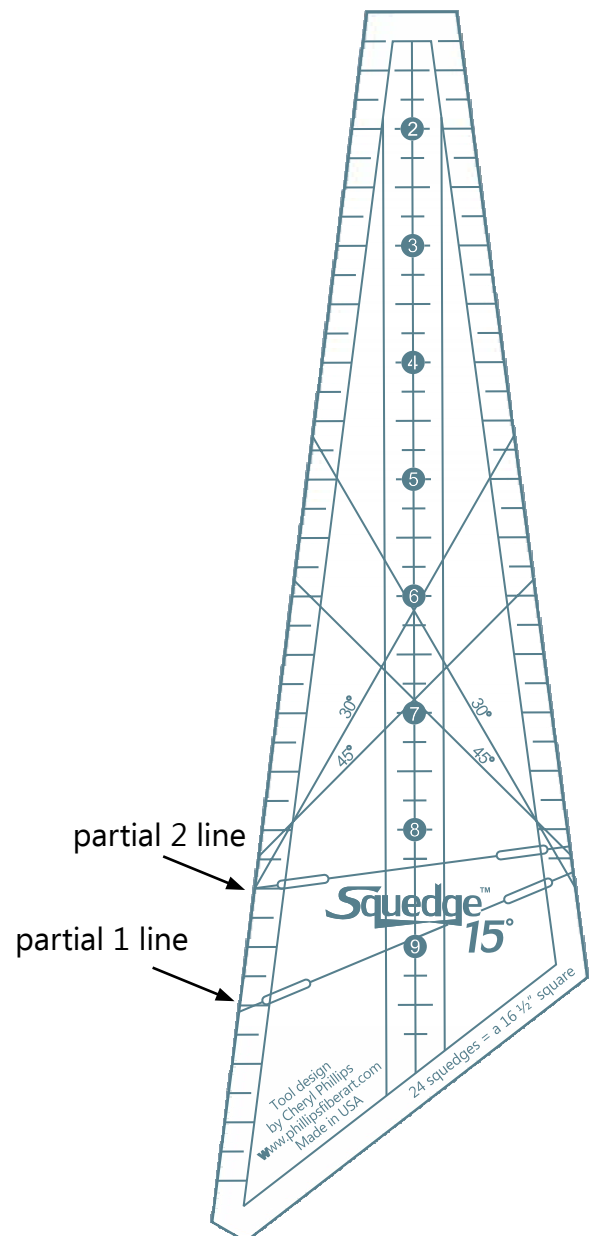
Fabric	Exact Amount	Suggested Yardage
A	18"	$\frac{5}{8}$ yd
B	12"	$\frac{1}{2}$ yd
C	20"	$\frac{3}{4}$ yd
D/Binding	24"	$\frac{7}{8}$ yd
Backing/Batting		52 x 20"

Fabric	Number of Strips	Strip Width
A	four	1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x width
	two	2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x width
B	four	2" x width
C	two	7 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x width
	one*	3 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x width
D	two	7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x width
binding	four	2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x width

\*Cut into 3  $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares then in half diagonally for corners. See page 3 for instructions on adding corners.

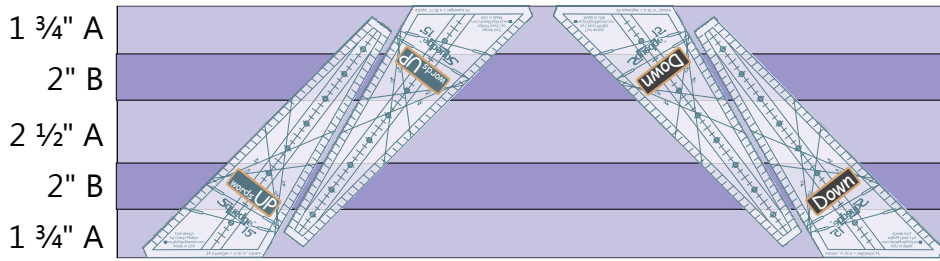
## Tool Preparation

Apply non-slip adhesive rings to both the back and front sides of the tool. You need to have these on both sides as you'll be cutting pieces with the tool flipped over.

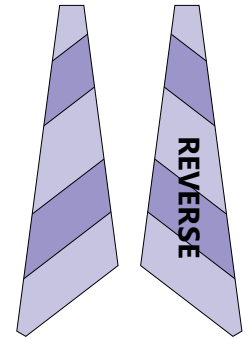


Helpful labels for the strip sets are found on page 5.

Always Sew with Exact 1/4" Seams



Set 1 (make two)



Cut 10 Cut 10

Place the tool on the strip set so bottom of the tool is aligned with the edge of the strip set.

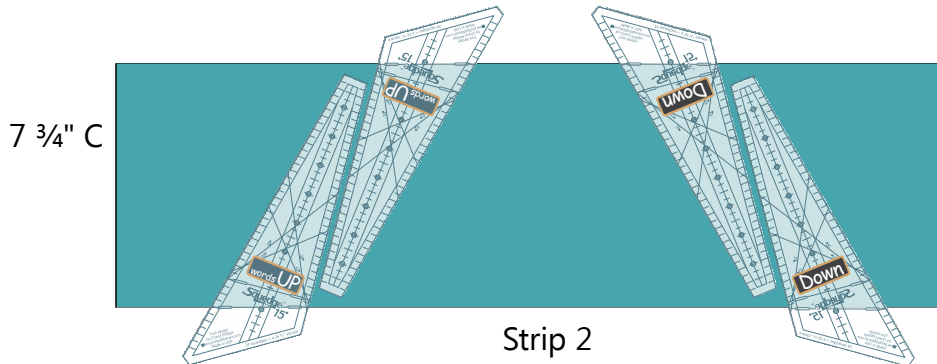
The words on the tool are **UP**.

Cut 10 of the *full* tool shape.

Place the tool on the strip set so bottom of the tool is aligned with the edge of the strip set.

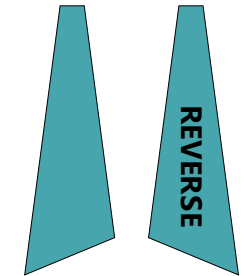
The words on the tool are **DOWN**.

Cut 10 of the *reverse full* tool shape.



Yes, the tool extends beyond the strip.

Strip 2



Cut 10 Cut 10

Align the Partial 1 slots of the tool to the edge of the strip.

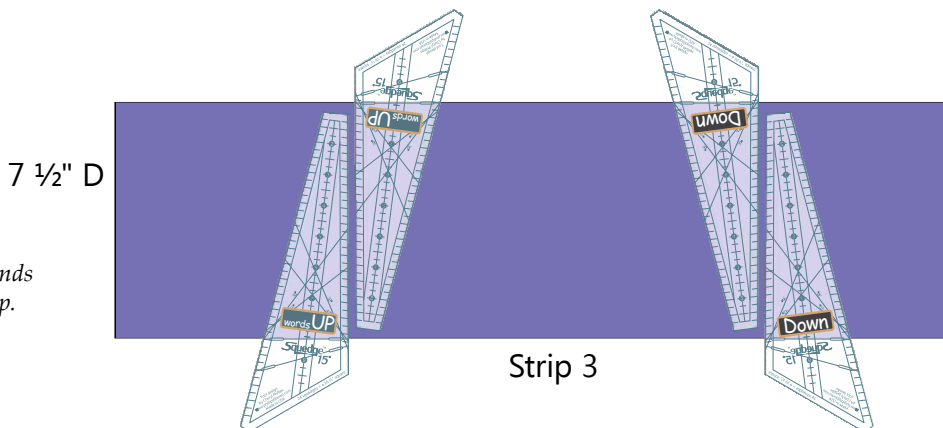
The words on the tool are **UP**.

Cut 10 of the *partial 1* tool shape.

Align the Partial 1 slots of the tool to the edge of the strip.

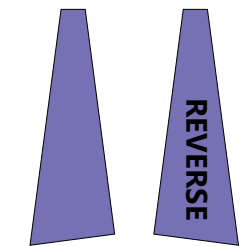
The words on the tool are **DOWN**.

Cut 10 of the *reverse partial 1* tool shape.



Yes, the tool extends beyond the strip.

Strip 3



Cut 10 Cut 10

Align the Partial 2 slots of the tool to the edge of the strip.

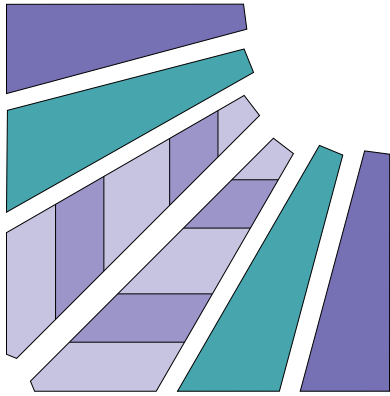
The words on the tool are **UP**.

Cut 10 of the *partial 2* tool shape.

Align the Partial 2 slots of the tool to the edge of the strip.

The words on the tool are **DOWN**.

Cut 10 of the *reverse partial 2* tool shape.



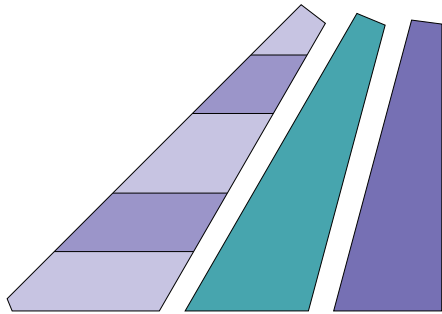
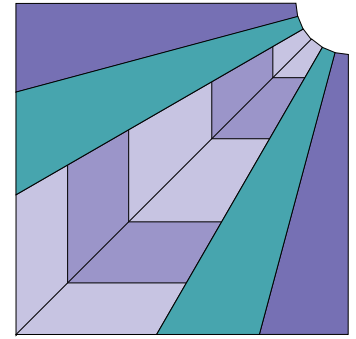
**Making Quads**

Arrange and sew your squedge pieces to make each quad.

Always Sew with Exact 1/4" Seams

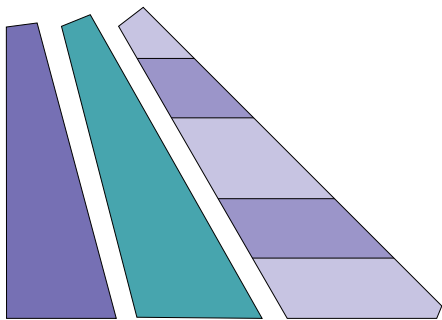
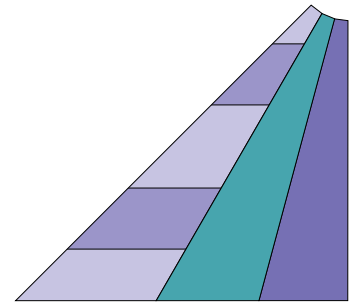


**Making Half Quads (right)**

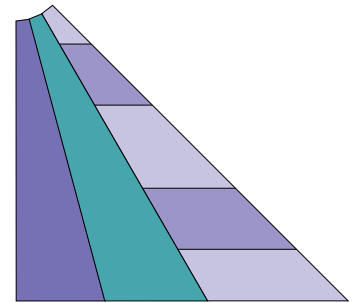


**Making Half Quads (left)**

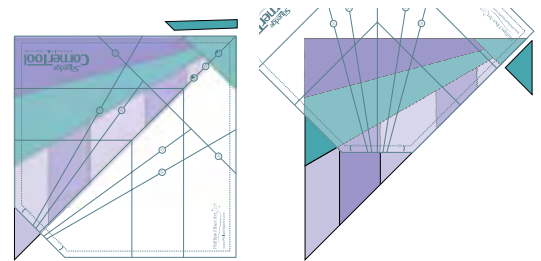
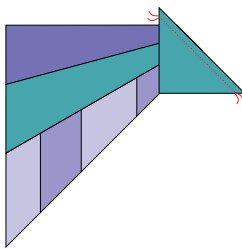
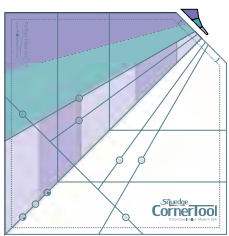
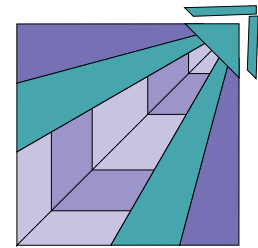
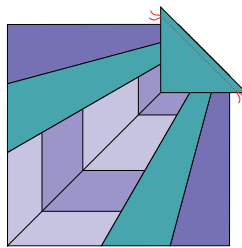
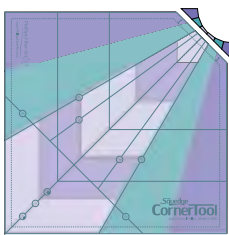
Arrange and sew your squedge pieces to make triangles.

**Adding Corner Squares**

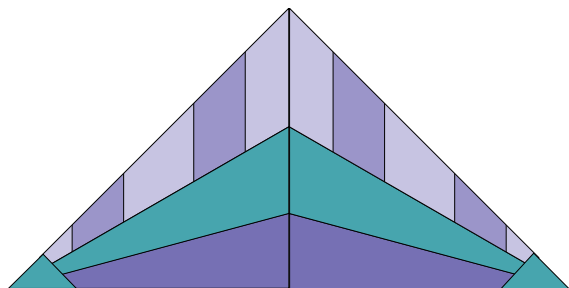


Using your Squedge Corner tool trim the corner of each quad and triangle.

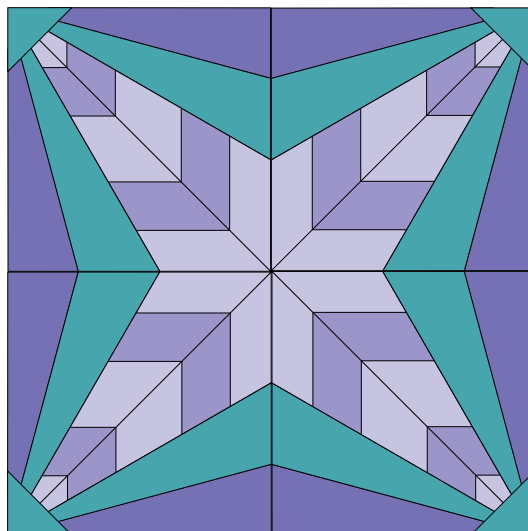
Add one corner triangle to each quad and triangle.

Trim excess corner fabric using the Squedge Corner tool.

Make 2 triangle sets.

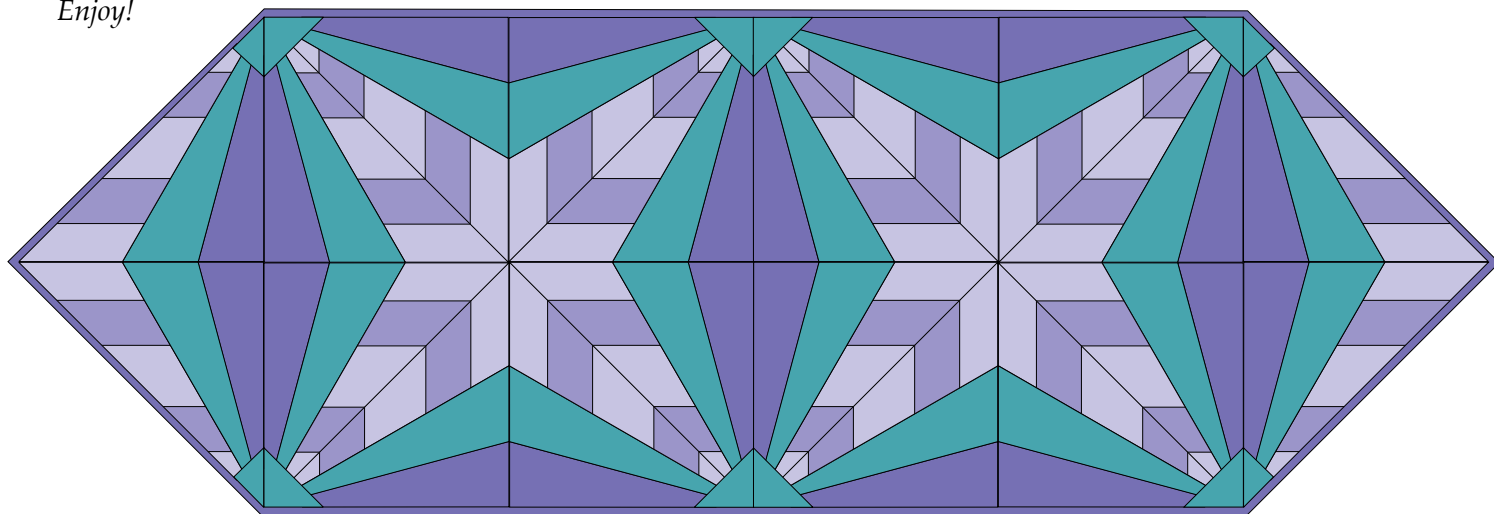


Make 2 blocks.

Assemble together into the runner.

Add backing, quilt as desired and bind.

1 3/4" A 2" B 2 1/2" A  
2" B 1 3/4" A

Align **Edge of tool**  
words facing **UP**

*Cut 10 full sqedges*

Set #2

7 3/4" C

Align **Partial 1 line**  
words facing **UP**

*Cut 10 partial 1 sqedges*

Set #3

7 1/2" D

Align **Partial 2 line**  
words facing **UP**

*Cut 10 partial 2 sqedges*

Set #1

1 3/4" A 2" B 2 1/2" A  
2" B 1 3/4" A

Align **Edge of tool**  
words facing **DOWN**

*Cut 10 reverse full sqedges*

Set #2

7 3/4" C

Align **Partial 1 line**  
words facing **DOWN**

*Cut 10 reverse partial 1 sqedges*

Set #3

7 1/2" D

Align **Partial 2 line**  
words facing **DOWN**

*Cut 10 reverse partial 2 sqedges*
